For the Intelligent Mind

Secular, scientific reasoning is revered as the final authority for truth. Revelation and faith are dismissed as unintelligent crutches for the naïve and ignorant. What could shock the secular mind more than an intelligent, secular reason for the existence of God or other spiritual truths?

Offering a reasonable and persuasive argument for your ideas can be achieved by answering four fundamental questions:

- 1. Is there more than a physical world?
- 2. Is there a God?
- 3. Who is this God?
- 4. How does God reveal His message to man?

The intelligent design movement in science is capturing the attention of many scientists today. Students are excited about learning about movement and others in order to answer probing questions and to offer good reasons in debate for why their faith is believable.

Doing the Math

Did you know that some consider that, "one of the most important technological changes in the history of the Western World took place during the Crusades, when Christian soldiers came across the Hindu-Arab system of numbers. The Hindu-Arabic system of numbers, so named because the Arabs found the numbering system during their invasion of India, replaced what we call

Roman numerals.... The Hindu-Arabic system of numbers allowed people to sail farther out to sea with greater accuracy; architecture could be more ambitious; time keeping could [be] more accurate; the human mind sharpened; and people thought more accurately, abstractly, and critically" (Robert Kiyosak).

Using a power base system of ten simplified the visual

aspect of numbers. This simplicity opened the way for discovery.

But a number system without a moral value system is insufficient to promote discovery. It was the moral code of integrity and belief in a world of design that gave rise to the incredible science of discovery we enjoy today. •

Preparing for the Demand!

Our contemporary sciencebased culture demands debate that will successfully persuade the skeptical mind with well-reasoned answers. Failure to successfully answer the challenges of science has led to a major abandonment of traditional values by youth.

Tragically, these teachings and values are unnecessarily rejected for lack of good answers. Unprepared students are captured and converted to secular world views.

The world is a battle field of

world view warfare encounters. and young people (future leaders) are the prized spoils. Warring ideologies of humanism struggle to make converts by capturing the minds and of youth hearts with persuasive arguments. The din of social and moral debate makes it impossible for many to think clearly and to make good decisions.

LTIA helps students sort through the maze of issues, to think clearly, and to defend their core beliefs. individuals, families, nations and cultures. LTIA trains students to think critically and to effectively present persuasive arguments. The fallacies of both secular and mystical world views are exposed, and sound, empirical evidence is given to argue favorably for traditional principles used to found our American culture. •

LTIA alumnus Kyndel Kovach respectfully stumped her professor in front of 300 students. When the class laughed at him, the professor responded saying that he was unprepared at the moment but would have an answer by the next class meeting. His answer was that any argument involving God was religion and therefore not worthy of discussion in the class. He refused to allow further discussion of "creation religion" in the class.

LTIA alumnus Marian Ward, who prayed, "the prayer heard around the world," credits LTIA with preparing her for the national attention she received. When challenged by her teachers, peers, community, and national organizations not to pray; she understood that she was engaged in world view warfare. She attributes LTIA with preparing her to meet this challenge. •
