

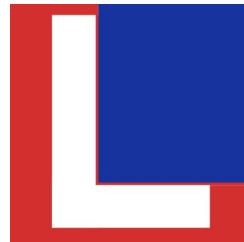
The LTIA Experience

- Leadership development workshops

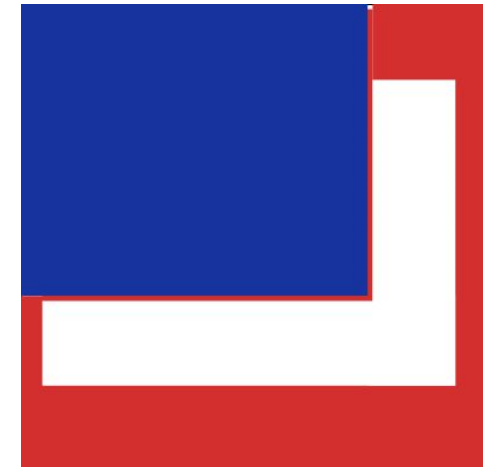
